

## **UKZN Academic re-admission applications for Semester 2 of 2020**

**Application for academic re-admission to UKZN in Semester 2 of 2020 will be considered, within Colleges, from individuals in the following categories,**

1. Previously excluded candidates who have met their exclusion conditions, and are close to completion of their qualification, who need to register for outstanding second semester modules in order to, potentially, be Degree Complete at the end of Semester 2:2020.
2. Currently unregistered candidates (i.e. not registered for Semester 1 of 2020) close to completion of their qualification, who need to register for outstanding second semester modules in order to, potentially, be Degree Complete at the end of Semester 2:2020.

### **Provided that;**

- (a) a valid curriculum for semester 2 can be constructed, and
- (b) the applicant has the requisite financial clearance, and
- (c) study place being available, taking the College specific enrolment target(s) into account.

### Noting that;

3. Students currently registered in Semester 1 of 2020 who need to register Semester 2: 2020 modules, are to use the change of curriculum process to add such modules. This need to be done as soon as the Semester 1:2020 results are released, but by no later than Friday 2 October 2020.
4. No new/first entry Honours, PGDip or Coursework Masters students will be considered for registration in Semester 2 of 2020.
5. A School/College process to consider registration of new Research Masters and Doctoral candidates against already defined criteria is in place and will continue to apply.
6. Successful applicants will not be eligible to return to campus unless they fall within the currently regulated categories for return to campuses as defined by the Minister, and in keeping with the decisions of the EMC Return to Campus Task Team. The details of all successful candidates will be provided to the EMC Return to Campus Task team, and the outcome of the Return to Campus Task Team deliberations is final.
7. Financial clearance will only be provided in keeping with the published UKZN criteria (see Student Fees web page for details).
8. While successful applicants will receive the appropriate data allocation, no provision for a device, other than that made to assist with subsidizing the purchase of a laptop by any successful applicant, will apply.

9. Residence space will be provisional on there being space (COVID 19 regulations apply) to accommodate a previous UKZN student housing resident;

10. All processes will need to occur remotely and via online means, so additional time for any potential delays needs to be factored in. Staff are working remotely/from off campus due to COVID 19 regulations. No responsibility can be accepted for mis-directed emails, load shedding or similar.

11. No appeal on any unsuccessful application will be entertained. The decision of the College is final.

12. The final date for **obtaining the requisite financial clearance and registering academically** is **Friday 18 September 2020 at 16h00**. No late applications will be considered.

13. The permit application system will only open for all successful candidates on Monday September 21, 2020. Monday 21 September is the first day of lectures for semester 2:2020. The student cards of successful applicants will be activated on 21 September 2020.
